The District:

The Amador Fire Protection District is an All-Risk Fire Department that responds to over 4,500 emergencies a year out of nine stations, and proudly serves a population of over 22,000 residents, covering 500-square miles of the unincorporated areas of Amador County and the City of Plymouth.

The Mechanic Position is Responsible for:

- Completing fire apparatus inspections and performing specialized, journey-level mechanical maintenance and repair work on all types of complex firefighting apparatus and related equipment
- Organizing and reviewing apparatus maintenance logs; communicating with Driver/Operators, and using manual techniques or computerized systems to diagnose operational problems on all types of firefighting apparatus and related equipment
- Troubleshooting and repair problems with a variety of complex hydraulic and electrical systems on firefighting apparatus
- Repair and maintain firefighting systems, pumps, and valves on the apparatus; repairing and maintaining fire auxiliary equipment, including extrication equipment, generators, small engines, foam systems, etc.
- Modifying, welding, and/or fabricating parts such as equipment and tool mounts, brackets, shelving, and perform minor cosmetic or body work on all apparatus
- Perform oil changes and replacing filters and fluids as part of the preventative maintenance service on fire apparatus
- Steam cleaning fire apparatus in order to clearly view the areas or parts to be inspected or repaired and maintaining a clean and secure work area, to include repair facility and vehicle

Minimum Qualifications:

- Valid California Commercial Class A/B License or Firefighter Restricted Class C License
- Obtain valid CPR/AED and Public Safety, First Aid certification within 90 days of hire
- Any combination of training, education, or experience equivalent to a minimum of five years' experience as a journey-level diesel and automotive mechanic, including experience in heavy-duty equipment maintenance or repair
- Special requirements; may have to provide own basic hand tools and roll-away box
- Must meet the qualifications to wear a tight-fitting respirator by passing a medical evaluation in accordance with AFPD district policy
- Must start working toward obtaining fire apparatus Emergency Vehicle Technician (EVT) certifications within one year of hire
